Student Misconduct

The Bruin Guide outlines our policies that are observed on and off campus and social media.

- The Bruin Guides applies to all current Belmont students who live **on or off campus and social media.**
- Belmont students who study aboard or participate in Belmont sanctioned trips **are held** to the standards of the Bruin Guide.

Highlighted Violations

Illegal substances are strictly prohibited on Belmont's campus as defined by federal and state laws.

- **Marijuana** is considered an **illegal substance in the state of Tennessee.**
- Having a medical Marijuana card or prescription **does NOT exempt students from this policy.**
- **Usage or possession of illegal substances or legal substances that were illegally obtained could lead to suspension or expulsion.**



Alcohol usage is strictly prohibited on Belmont's campus

- **Consumption, possession, distribution or impairment** is against the Bruin guide.
- **Underage** consumption, possession, and distribution is illegal by federal law.

Visitation and Practice hours are **observed daily**

- These hours are provided to you by your **RA or RD.**
- Hosting visitation or practicing outside of these hours **will result in a policy write up.**

File the FAFSA

FAFSA- Free Application for Federal Student Aid

- FAFSA is required for:
 - Federal aid and loans – Pell, Direct Student Loans/Parent Loans/Federal Work Study
 - *Loans and FWS require active accepting of the award*
 - State financial aid – TN Specific: Hope & TSAA
 - Belmont awarded need-based aid and grants
- Visit studentaid.gov to file your FAFSA each year
- Students will receive an email notification when completed





Dive Deeper into Federal Aid - Loans

- **Federal Direct Loans** (Interest Rate: 6.392%)
 - Unsubsidized – accrue interest
 - Subsidized – need-based; interest is paid for you
- **Parent PLUS Loans** (Interest Rate: 8.942%)
 - Require an application
 - Higher interest than Direct Loans
- **Alternative Loans**
 - Like PLUS Loans but vary significantly
 - Require a lot of research but can be competitive



Institutional scholarships + grants

- ✓ **Requires full-time enrollment**

12+ credit hours, typically 4-5 courses per semester

Course Program of Study (CPOS)

IMPORTANT: The courses you register for could affect your financial aid options and eligibility.

State and Federal Aid will disburse based on the number of hours you are taking that count toward your degree program.

If you register for fewer than full time in-program hours (12 hours for UG students), your financial aid + overall Cost of Attendance (the max amount of financial aid you can receive) may be reduced.
